

The Bradford Gun Club held its 14th annual Spring Ironman shoot on Sunday. This unique event requires the shooting participants to shoot all four venues available at BGC. Shooters fire at 25 each of skeet, 5- Stand and trap (from the 23 yard line) as well as 50 sporting clays targets. A total of 47 shooters competed in the event.
