

The Bradford Gun Club held its 33rd annual Memorial trap shoot on Sunday. This ATA registered trap shoot recognizes club members and area shooters who have passed away. Dave Cichelli, of Leicester, NY claimed the high-over-all award with a score of 282 X 300. Cichelli had a 97 X 100 in singles, 94 X 100 in handicap and a 91 X 100 in doubles. Just one target back with scores of 281 X 300 were Bradford's Fred Gainer and Rich Long of Coudersport

In the singles event Mike Dietz of Corry led all shooters with a near perfect 99 X 100. A 95 X 100 by Tidoute's Joel Stewart was the top score in the handicap event. Long's 92 X 100 was the best score in the doubles event. Score details by event follow:
