High-over-all on the three events was Bradford's Fred Gainer with a 284 X 300. Gainer had a 98 X 100 in singles, a 90 X 100 in handicap and a 96 X 100 in doubles. Tied for the HOA runner-up spot with a 281 X 300 were Jeffrey Fenton of Clairton and Brandon Deal of Petrolia.
