This unique and challenging event requires the shooters to fire at 25 each of skeet, 5-Stand and trap (from the 23 yard line) targets as well as 50 sporting clays targets. The excellent weather resulted in a record turnout of 116 shooters from the tri-state area.

Claiming the high-over-all trophy was Mike Esch with a 113 X 125. Esch had a 22 X 25 in trap, a 24 X 25 in skeet, a 21 X 25 in 5-Stand and a 46 X 50 in sporting clays. Two shooters were one target behind with 112 X 125. These shooters were Mike Pancerev and Andy Maliszewski.
